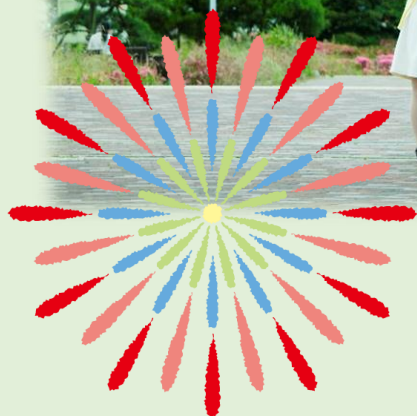

Summer Program 2019, Niigata University Calls for Applications

1. Introduction

Niigata University offers a tuition free course taught in English for its overseas partner universities. The program aims to provide participants with opportunities to encounter and explore Japanese & Niigata's tradition and culture. We hope that this program contributes to expand participants' horizon and evoke their interest toward Studying in Niigata University.

2. Program Fees

- Tuition fee: Free
- Niigata University will bear the costs of accommodation (8 nights from August 21st to August 28th), and field trips including an excursion.
- * At students' own expense:
 - International travel expenses between students' home country and Japan as well as domestic travel expenses between the port of entry and Niigata Station or Niigata Airport.
 - Commuting cost between Niigata University and your accommodation.
(Bus: one-way JPY 440, Train: one-way JPY 240)
 - Travel insurance: students must obtain full insurance coverage for themselves.

3. Contents

- ◆ Japanese language for beginners
- ◆ Japanese culture
- ◆ Field trip: Global Connectivity of Niigata University, Research Institutes and Enterprises
- ◆ Excursion: Includes cultural experiences in Niigata
This excursion invites participants to explore Niigata's deep cultural heritage and a rich food culture.

*Each lecture will be 90 minutes long.

*Some contents may be changed.

4. Credit Recognition

Participants who successfully complete the program will earn 2 credits from Niigata University.



5. Accommodation

Check in: August 21st

Check out: August 29th

Niigata University will arrange hotel or hostel in Niigata City.

*Detailed information will be provided at a later date.

6. Eligibility

Those who are eligible to apply are:

- 1) students who are proficient in English,
- 2) students of overseas partner universities, and
- 3) students who are physically and mentally in good health so as to complete the program successfully.

7. Total number of participants

The maximum number of participants to be accepted will be 40 in total.

8. How To Apply

All applications must be made through your home university, not by individual students. Submit the following 2 items to the exchange coordinator (or international affairs office) of your university by the following due date.

Application Deadline: May 15th, 2019

1. Application Form (Paste your photo image)

2. PDF copy of a passport (ID page)

Application results will be announced to your university's responsible office in the middle of June. Students will receive notification regarding the results of their application through their home university. Please do not book a flight until you receive notification regarding the results.

You may need a short term visitor visa to enter Japan, depending on your nationality. Please refer to the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan for further information.
