Pacific National University was founded in 1958 as Khabarovsk Automobile Highway Institute. In 1962, it was reorganized into a multidisciplinary educational institution –Khabarovsk Polytechnic Institute, which began training specialists for the developing industries of the Far Eastern region. Over the years, the university has trained more than 100,000 specialists in all major sectors of the economy and social sphere of the Far East.

Today, PNU is one of the largest universities in the Far East and the Center for innovative, technological, and social development of the region.

The university offers bachelor's, master's, and doctoral degree programs in 5 institutes and 12 faculties in a wide range of disciplines: engineering, economics, architecture, science, law, and education. There are over 14,5 thousand students and more that 900 academic staff.

PNU has 21 academic exchange programs, 6 double degree programs, 122 international partners, more than 1,000 foreign students from over 30 countries, over 2,500 foreign alumni, membership in 9 international university associations.
