Saratov State University was founded in 1909 by the highest decree of the Emperor Nicholas II. Nowadays SSU is one of the largest Russian universities, recognized as one of the leading Universities. It is included in the International QS and Times Higher Education Rankings. In 2010 the University gained the National Research Status. The University body: 12 faculties, 9 educational institutions, 2 colleges. The University also represents basic departments at schools, at industrial enterprises and institutions, a variety of scientific, research and innovation structures. This year a new Faculty of Fundamental Medicine and Medical Technologies has been founded at Saratov State University. More than 20 000 students follow academic programs at Saratov State University. The academic staff exceeds 1200 members.
