SCHOOL OF INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS



The School of International Relations is the oldest one at MGIMO. Founded in 1943, it is the first specialized school of international relations in Eurasia. The approaches and teaching methods that have been developed over these years form the core of our training standard.

Let me remind you that the hallmark of a graduate of the School of International Relations is fluency in two foreign languages. Although undergraduate students do not receive a degree in translation or linguistics, their proficiency in most cases is not only on par with that of the linguistic universities' graduates, but even better when it comes to complex political negotiations, public speeches in host countries, or interactions with the media.

The unique feature of training at the School is the practice-oriented approach. We focus on helping students to organize their unsupervised work, which is an essential element of training our graduates.

International and dual degree Master's programs are worthy of separate attention. Their obvious advantages are studying in an international environment in English, developing universal, or soft skills, the so-called social skills that are most in-demand in any profession today. These programs are taught in cooperation with the leading foreign universities, such as Sciences Po in Paris, Freie Universität Berlin, Humboldt University, LUISS, Peking University, Seoul National University, the School of Advanced International Studies at Johns Hopkins University (USA), and others.

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The training of international lawyers at MGIMO is based on the comparative-legal approach, which implies thorough studying of foreign and international law. It enables our students and graduates to be familiar with a variety of legal issues, relying not only on Russian legislation and law-enforcement practice but also on the experience of other states with a different legal tradition. This is the feature that distinguishes the School's curriculum from that of other law schools, focusing mostly on the Russian legislation.

The training of international lawyers is complemented by studying foreign languages through the legal lens so that the students and graduates of the School could work with their counterparts from other countries.

The training at MGIMO is based on an individual approach, which allows identifying students' abilities for various types of professional activities.

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The School of Applied Economics and Commerce became an independent structural unit in February 2011. Compared to other MGIMO schools, it is a very young one. There are two main areas: Ecology and Natural Resource Management, and Commerce.

The topic of ecology is now more relevant than ever before. The overwhelming majority of our students work in the specialized departments responsible for the environmental social responsibility of business in such companies as Sibur, Leroy Merlin, KPMG, Ernst&Young.

The main departments at Commerce program are the Department of Applied Economics and the Department of Commerce and Trade Regulation. For the School, applied economics primarily means an "umbrella" covering a wide range of practice-oriented disciplines, which shape the students' competencies to work at the level of companies and industries involved in one way or another in international trade.



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The School of International Business and Business Administration was created at the most difficult time in the new Russian history – in 1992. Then, as well as now, its founders were guided by two main ideas.

The first one was that those Russian managers, who had received fundamental training in accordance with the best traditions of Russian education and mastered at least two foreign languages, can be competitive with foreign ones.

And I assure you: that turned out to be the case. The graduates of our School (precisely thanks to the classical approach to the curriculum and the solid practical experience in education) are now working in the largest foreign and Russian companies as well as in the Russian civil service.

The second one is a well-known dualism. The founders of the School have always believed that you cannot be the manager without knowing what you are managing. In our case, it is any foreign economic activity, primarily the one associated with foreign investments, especially those proceeding from Russia.

We are looking for new students, who are ready for intensive and hard work and who understand that soon they will be strengthening the position of the Russian Federation in a world which, unfortunately, is becoming more and more turbulent.

SCHOOL OF GOVERNMENT AND INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS



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Established in 2012, in 2013 the School launched the Government and International Affairs program, which became Russia's first bachelor's degree program in the social sciences taught fully in English.

Today the School has four bachelor's programs in English with 225 students from 33 countries. Most of them have received IB, A-level, GCSE / iGCSE certificates. In 2018, MGIMO and the University of Reading (UK) opened a double degree program in Politics and International Relations for Russian high school graduates taking the USE. Students spend their first two years in Moscow and the final two years in Reading, Britain's "Silicon Valley." Together with the Marbel International University Center (Spain), the School teaches the Global Politics program. We are developing promising collaborations with Princeton University and the Georgia Institute of Technology (USA). In 2021, the School is launching a Bachelor's degree program in International Business and Finance.

SCHOOL OF FINANCIAL **ECONOMY**



Our School has four departments that train students and conduct research in three interrelated areas: economics, management and business informatics. The total number of faculty members is 38; 8 are Doctors of Sciences, 27 - Candidates of Sciences.

All of our School's programs offer first-class training in one or, optionally, two foreign languages with a particular emphasis on professional usage of the language.

We position our School as a data analytics competence center. In December 2020, together with Google, we held The Magic and Reality of Machine Learning. In this first experimental workshop, students from different academic backgrounds took on a data analysis project leader's role.s We are updating four programs based on the takeaways from the workshop to better prepare students for practical work with data in their respective fields of specialization.

Our Artificial Intelligence program is one of the first MA in Russia that prepares a new generation of technology leaders capable of building processes to design and promote Al-based products and services.

SCHOOL OF LINGUISTICS AND CROSS-CULTURAL COMMUNICATION





























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The hallmark of the School of Linquistics and Cross-Cultural Communication are two mandatory foreign languages that students begin to study in their freshman vear. The first foreign language is English; it is the language of instruction for 40 to 70 % of the subjects depending on the year. The second foreign language is European (French, German, Spanish or Italian). The second foreign language is assigned to the student group based on the preferences of admitted students, the School's needs, and the Foreign Languages Department's capacities.

The School is working on an international consortium on linguistics (terminology, cultural linguistics and computational linguistics) and modern languages that unites leading universities and companies. The School's main international and Russian partners are the University of Georgia (US), the University Institute of Modern Languages (Milan, Italy), and the Rudomino National Library.

In February, students help organize and host a renowned international research workshop, an international research conference entitled 'Language, Culture. Translation'. In 2021, the main topic of the forum is modern technologies in linguistics. This workshop offers a unique opportunity to meet leading interpreters and translators, researchers and experts in the field.

EUROPEAN STUDIES INSTITUTE



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The European Studies Institute (ESI) is a unique joint project of Russia and the EU. More than 800 public sector employees have already received their master's degrees in International Relations, Law and Economics at the ESI.

The ESI has designed more than 30 short-term courses on Russia-EU relations, European integration, European law, human rights protection mechanisms and anti-corruption to address specific staff needs that ministries, public bodies and businesses have. More than 3500 public servants, judges, researchers working in the private sector, and university tutors have received their advanced training certificates.

The ESI's guest lecturers are professors and experts from international organizations such as the EAEU, the EU, the UN, Council of Europe, which proves that European/international and Russian methodologies can successfully blend together in a university environment.

Since 2009 the European Studies Institute has offered an additional Master's program in International Protection of Human Rights as part of the Consortium of Russian Universities initiative. This unique initiative allows Russia's nine leading universities to collaborate on this program and offer truly interdisciplinary content.

SCHOOL OF PRE-UNIVERSITY TRAINING



Ever since MGIMO was founded, the pre-university training system was a crucial element in increasing admissions quality. In its current form, the School of Pre-University Training was established in 2011, never stopping to develop and evolve. Traditional pre-university training methods continuously improve and are used alongside innovative solutions.

A wide range of pre-university training programs offered today allows training annually more than 1200 students from all across Russia and other countries.

For those who do not have an opportunity to attend preparatory courses in person, MGIMO has designed one-year and six-month remote courses in English focused on preparing students for both the Unified State Exam and MGIMO's in-house admissions English exam. The Center for Cooperation with Schools, a subdivision of the School of Pre-University Training, holds a number of career orientation events and helps other MGIMO's Schools organize the Pre-Professional Skills Competition in Economics and Public Administration.
