<p>Study Abroad Program Options</p> <p>Notes on Credit Points (CP) at UTS</p> <p>Variation of Study Abroad Program</p>	<p>Students can select from three UTS Study Abroad options. It is important that they indicate the correct program on their online application.</p>		
	<p>Study Abroad Program</p> <p>Enrol in a full-time study load – 24 credit points (24CP) per session. Students may study at UTS for one or two sessions. A set Study Abroad tuition fee applies.</p>	<p>Study Abroad 18</p> <p>Enrol in Study Abroad, but with a reduced study load of 18 credit points (18CP) and a lower tuition fee applies.*</p>	<p>Australian Language and Cultural (ALAC) Studies</p> <p>Some students choose study our 24CP Australian Language and Cultural Studies Program if they have lower language entry scores to experience study at UTS, learn about Australia and improve their language proficiency.</p>
	<p>*NOTE: UTS recommends that Study Abroad Program and Study Abroad 18 students be aware of the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 24CP = 30 ECTS or 15 US Credit Hours - 18CP = 22.5 ECTS or 12 US Credit Hours 18CP is the minimum full time load at UTS to maintain a valid Australian student visa. Most UTS faculties offer 6CP subjects, but some use 8CP subjects. A combination of different faculty subjects may require enrolling above 18CP (or 24CP). Tuition fees rates are adjusted upward for any additional credit points enrolled. 2017 rate – AU\$412/CP. Students may change their program, after submission and before arrival, by completing a UTS Change of Program form and return this to Studyabroad.Exchange@uts.edu.au. Please remind applicants that changes between Study Abroad options after arrival at UTS will not be permitted.

Awards	<p>All students will be automatically assessed for a UTS Study Abroad Excellence Award. This award is given to students with high academic achievement. The Award is worth AU\$2,000.00 for the Study Abroad 24CP Option, and AU\$1,000.00 for the Study Abroad 18CP Option.</p>			
OSHC	<p>Students are required to purchase Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) if they are intending to apply for a student visa. We recommend Medibank Private, however students may see other providers here.</p> <p>Students will be sent instructions on how to purchase this insurance at point of offer. We do not purchase OSHC on behalf of students. If a student pays us for the OSHC premium with their tuition fees, they will be issued a refund after their arrival in Sydney.</p>

Requesting New Subjects after the Online Application	<p>Requesting New Subjects after the Online Application has been submitted</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It is important that students research their subject choice well before submitting their online application. If they wish to submit additional subjects later they would be required to complete the ‘UTS Additional Subject Request’ form and email it to Studyabroad.Exchange@uts.edu.au <p>After the student has been admitted to UTS Students will need to submit their request through the UTS eRequest system. Below are some tips on submitting eRequests</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Submit one eRequest with all the subjects you wish to request</i> • <i>Make sure students write in the Textbox why they want the subjects</i> • <i>If subjects requested are ‘not approved’ ask for suggested alternative subject options.</i>

Applicants can apply online and should enter their UTS Student Number (the same as their UTS Application Number) and select 'Exchange' or 'Study Abroad' as their Student Type.</p> <p>Housing Fees: A non-refundable application fee of \$40 applies.
