[For Prospective Doctoral Students Starting in April 2026] Niigata University Scholarship for Graduate School Doctoral Programs Application Guidelines

1. Purpose

The purpose of this scholarship program is to support students who are enrolled in a Master's degree program or a professional degree program of a graduate school at Niigata University with excellent academic records, and have an intension to continue their study in a doctoral program at Niigata University, but are being forced to discontinue their study due to a financial difficulty. The program aims to motivate such students to advance to a doctoral program, and eventually to foster the growth of young researchers by providing them with a scholarship award to finance a part of educational cost necessitated when starting a doctoral program.

2. Scholarship

300,000 yen (one-time payment)

Although repayment is not required, the scholarship money must be returned in any of the following cases.

- When a recipient leaves, or is expelled from a graduate school within the first year of a doctoral program.
- When a recipient receives disciplinary action within the first year of a doctoral program.
- When false information is found in the contents of the application documents.
- When there is a fact that definitively suggests that a recipient is inappropriate as a scholarship student.

3. Number of scholarship recipients

27 people

4. Eligibility

Students who can apply for this scholarship program must be enrolled in a Niigata University Master's Program and must fulfill all of the following requirements.

- ① To be an applicant who takes the screening of a doctoral program in any of the graduate schools of Niigata University in AY2025, and who completes all examinations by the end of February of 2026.
- ② To be able to promise to enter the doctoral program in April of 2026.
- To have not received disciplinary action while attending the master's program.
- The total income of the student and his/her spouse (who has a regular employment income) does not exceed 3.4 million yen in 2024 (*). If the spouse is a salaried employee, the amount of only the spouse's income after employment income deduction should be added to the amount of the student's income.

2024, the estimated income in 2025 will be used to determine the students' eligibility for the scholarship. In this case, the estimated income in 2025 should not exceed 3.4 million yen.

5. Ineligible recipients

This scholarship will not be awarded to students who fall under any of the following categories (\bigcirc - \bigcirc) at the time of enrollment in a doctoral program. Additionally, if a recipient of this scholarship is found to fall under any of the following categories (\bigcirc - \bigcirc) at the time of entering the doctoral program, they will lose their eligibility for the scholarship.

- ① Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS) Research Fellows
- ② Japanese Government (MEXT) scholarship students
- ③ International students sponsored by foreign governments
- Recipients of the Niigata University Support for Pioneering Research Initiated by the Next Generation

- (1) Among the prospective scholarship recipients, those who pass the screening of a doctoral program in April 2026 will be approved to become scholarship recipients.
- (2) In the event that the number of those who receive scholarship is less than the number of recipients, due to reasons such as the selection result of a doctoral program of prospective scholarship recipients, the scholarship offer is passed on to the next candidate on the waiting list.
- (3) The final selection results will be notified to all applicants through Academic Affairs Information System (Student Web System) in April 2026.

10. Scholarship payment

- (1) The scholarship will be transferred to the recipients' designated bank account on May of 2026 after NU has confirmed that the recipients have been enrolled in their program.
- (2) In the event that a vacancy occurs due to admission decline etc., the scholarship offer is passed on to the next candidate on the waiting list.

11. Treatment of personal information

The name, address, and other personal information provided in the application for this scholarship will only be used for the ① selection and determination of scholarship recipients, ② research and analysis of the scholarship system, and ③ tasks related to them.
