NATIONAL TAICHUNG THEATER



The Taichung National Theater is located in Xitun District, Taichung City. It is a unique large-scale public performance space. It was designed by Japanese architect Toyo Ito. It is unique in the world based on the most primitive concepts of "cave" and "crypt". The curved wall building took 5 years to complete and cost TWD 4.36 billion. It was finally completed and opened on November 23, 2014. It is planned to include a grand theater, a Chinese theater and a small experimental theater, which can accommodate a total of about 3,000 people.

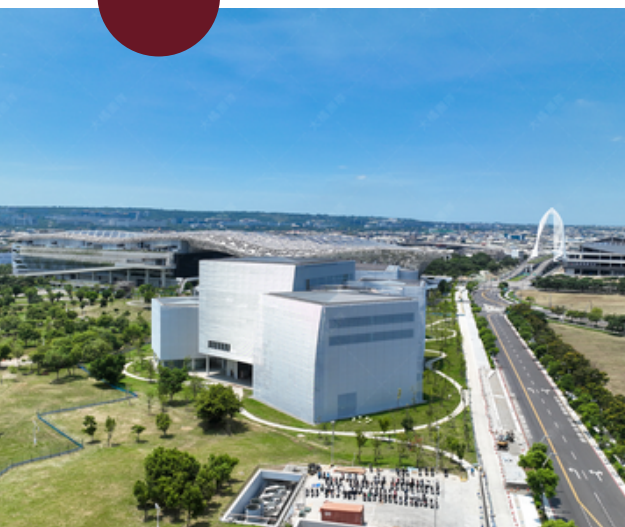
Sun Moon Lake is located in Nantou County in central Taiwan. It was officially upgraded to the "Sun Moon Lake National Scenic Area" in January 1989. It is built into an international-class resort based on the beautiful scenery of Sun Moon Lake and the cultural characteristics of the Thao people.

Sun Moon Lake is the largest natural inland lake in Taiwan, with an altitude of 760 meters. It is surrounded by mountains, the lake surface is sparkling, and the morning and sunset views are even more charming. The magnificent scenery is too beautiful to take in.

GREEN MUSEUMBRARY



The Taichung Green Museumbrary is located on the north side of Central Park within Shuinan Economic and Trade Park, near Zhongke Road and Liming Road. Its architecture is designed by SANAA, founded by Kazuyo Sejima and Ryue Nishizawa, in collaboration with Ricky Liu & Associates Architects+Planners from Taiwan. It is a cultural complex that combines the Taichung Art Museum and the Taichung Public Library.

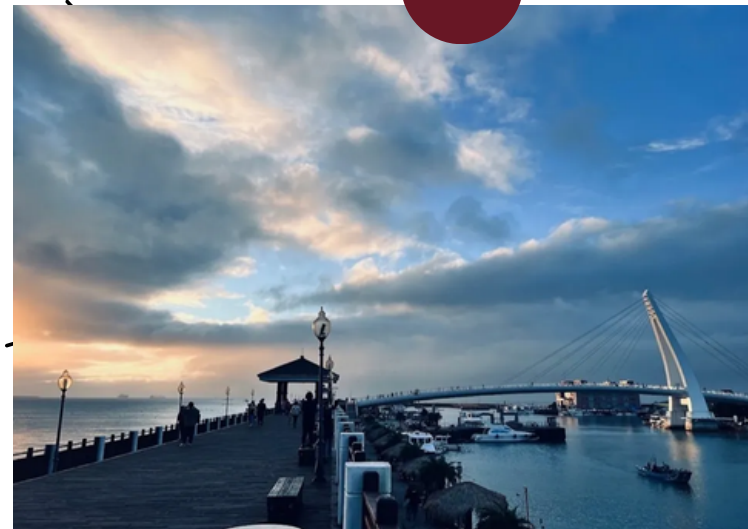


DADAOCHENG

Discover the charm of old Taipei in Dadaocheng, where historic Dihua Street offers traditional shops, tea houses, and local snacks. Visit the famous Xiahai City God Temple, known for granting love and marriage wishes. With its blend of heritage, culture, and creativity, this area is a must-see for every traveler.

TAMSUI OLD STREET

Located by the riverside, Tamsui Old Street is a lively historic area known for its street food, local crafts, and charming shops. Sample famous snacks like iron eggs and fish ball soup as you walk along the scenic water front. Enjoy sunset views over the Tamsui River, making this a perfect day-trip destination from Taipei.



TAIPEI 101

Taipei 101 is a super high-rise skyscraper located in Xinyi District, Taipei City. It is 508 meters high, with 101 floors above ground and 5 floors underground. It was the tallest building in the world from its completion on December 31, 2004 to January 4, 2010. It is currently the tallest building in Taiwan and the only building in Taiwan with a height of more than 500 meters and more than 100 floors.
